DID YOU KNOW

- HIV infection rates are 3-16 times higher among people *without* stable housing.
- People who found stable housing reduced their risky activities by 50 percent.
- Stable housing allows people with HIV keep medicine schedules, reducing viral loads and the risk of HIV transmission.
